### Additional Costs

#### School Uniforms

The dress code is published in the Student/Parent Handbook. There is a copy of the dress code included in this packet. All of our uniform pants and plaid pieces will be ordered through LandsEnd using our Customer Number 9001-2693-9. Shirts and sweaters will be ordered through MacKellars (either on-line or by mailing in their order form) and all of these items will have the St. Mary Catholic School logo on them.

#### Gym Uniforms

Students must wear navy blue sweatpants with school logo or navy gym shorts with school logo and a navy blue tee-shirt with logo or sweatshirt with logo for gym class. Non-marking sneakers for the gym floor. The gym uniforms will be ordered through MacKellars.

### **Optional Costs**

#### **Latchkey**

Latchkey is available from 7:00 – 8:00 a.m. and from 3:15 – 6:30 p.m.

There is a \$25.00 yearly registration fee for every family that uses Latchkey. Latchkey rates are \$4.50 for the first child and \$2.50 each for every additional child.

#### **Lunch**

The following are available at school: Hot lunch with milk for \$2.50;

Chocolate or white milk for .30¢; \$1.50 for an extra entrée. Ice cream is sold at lunch, Mondays and Fridays, for .75¢.

### **Tuition Policy**

For a family to qualify for an In-Parish tuition rate, they must be active parishioners for one full year prior to registration.

For a family to qualify for the "Service" tuition rate, they must support the school through service (Auction/Raffle/Service Hours).

The "Non-Service" tuition rate is the rate for those families who choose not to support the school through service (Auction/Raffle/Service Hours).

Tuition is due on the same day of each month. You may choose to have your payment deducted from your bank account on the 5<sup>th</sup> or the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month. A finance charge of 1.5% will be added to accounts for payments received after your due date.

There will be a \$35.00 charge for each check returned by our bank.

Tuition deposits are non-refundable. Tuition is non-refundable after February 1, 2010.

Tuition refunds (pro-rated) are given only if a family moves out of the area, or if for the child's welfare, the school recommends a change.

### **Fundraising/Service Policy**

As a condition of registration at St. Mary Catholic School, each family agrees to support the school through fundraising efforts. St. Mary School has the following fundraisers for the 2009-2010 school year that all will be required to participate in.

#### **Fundraising/Service #1**

There is a requirement for families with one child to work twelve service hours and families with more than one child to work seventeen service hours during the 2009-2010 school year. There will be a sign-up sheet at approved fund-raising events that must be signed by the volunteer for the service hours to be applied. The school office will have a record of the service hours worked. Service hours must be approved by the school office and any hours that aren't completed would be assessed a fee of \$32.00 per hour.

#### **Fundraising/Service #2**

St. Mary has a spring Auction that is both festive and a lot of fun. Every family is required to buy two Auction tickets (Total cost would be \$130.00).

#### **Fundraising/Service #3**

St. Mary has a Daily Number Raffle for which each family will be required to sell tickets. The raffle will be held five times during the school year. Tickets will be \$10.00 each. The tickets will be good for one month and there will be a winner each day for that month. Each family will be obligated to sell or buy ten tickets for each month. (Total cost would be \$500.00)
